



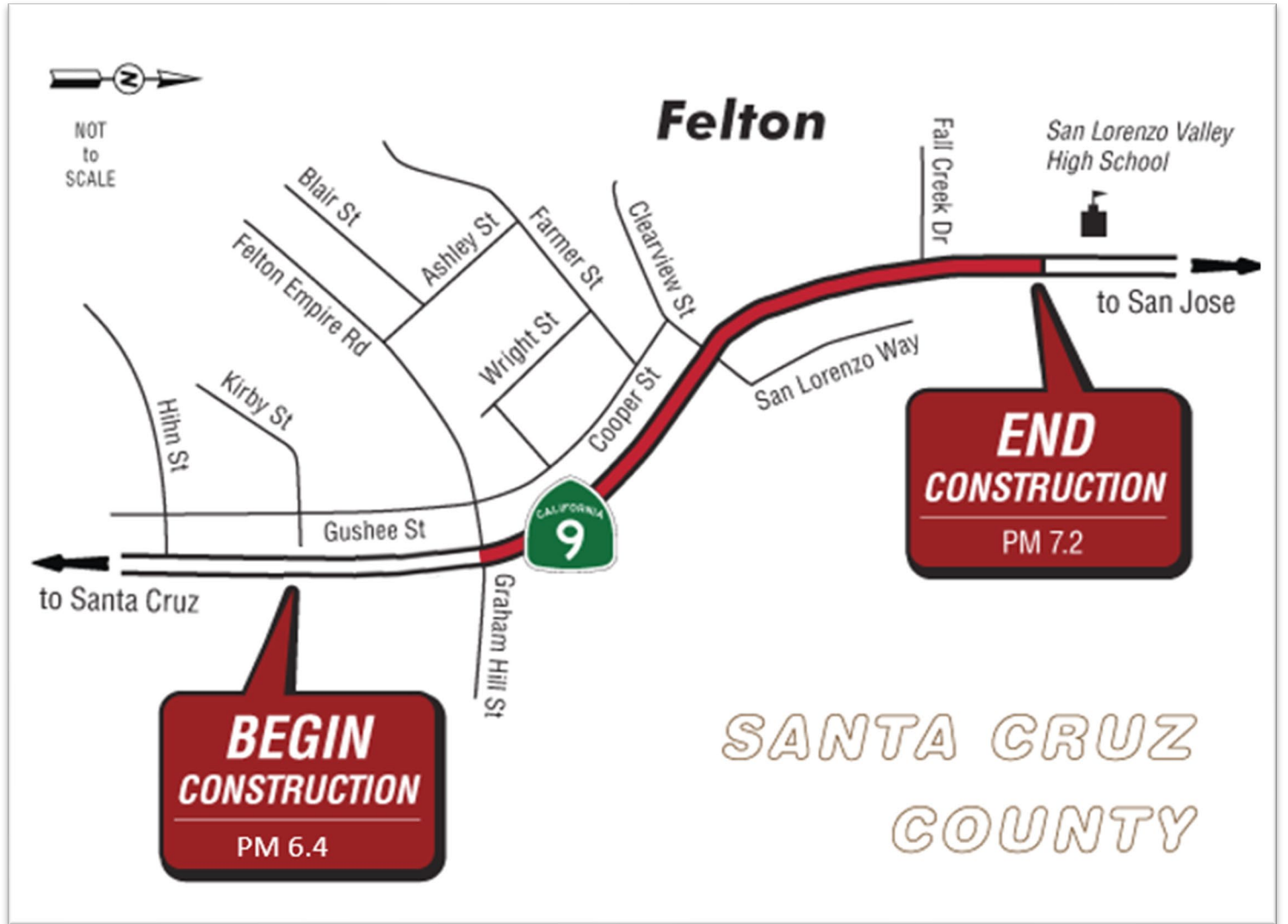

PROJECT OVERVIEW

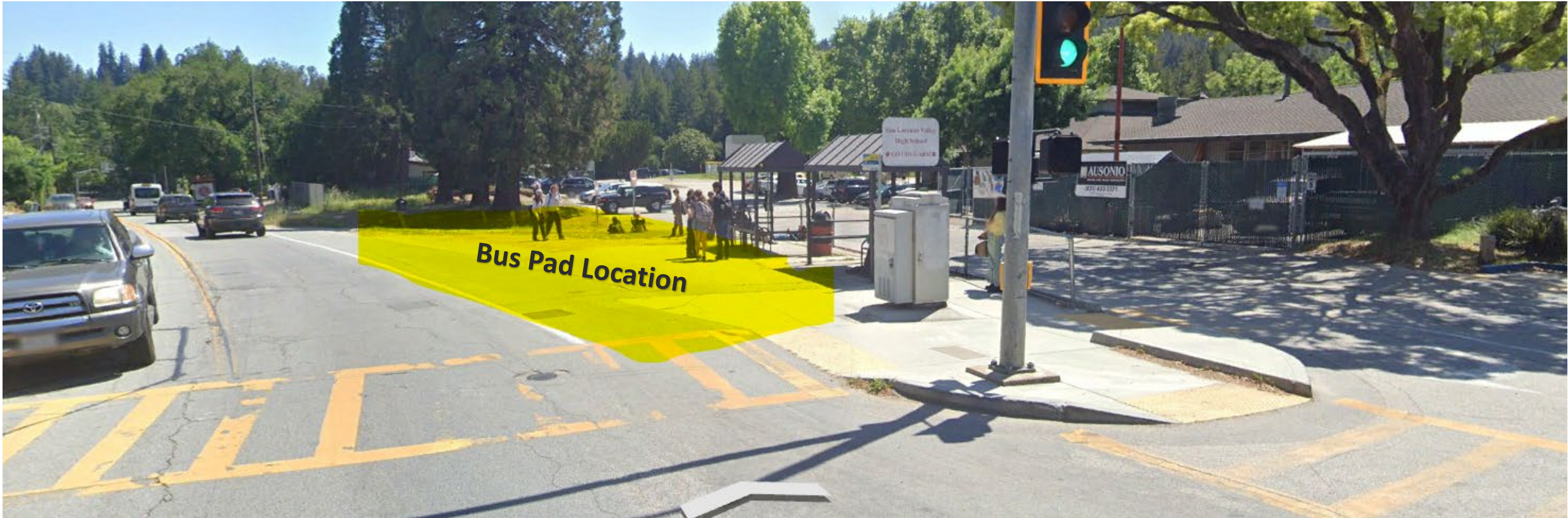
- 4-6-foot-wide sidewalks, curbs, and gutters on the southbound side of State Route 9 from Graham Hill Road to the San Lorenzo Valley School Complex
- Shoulder widening to a minimum of 4 feet on the southbound side of State Route 9

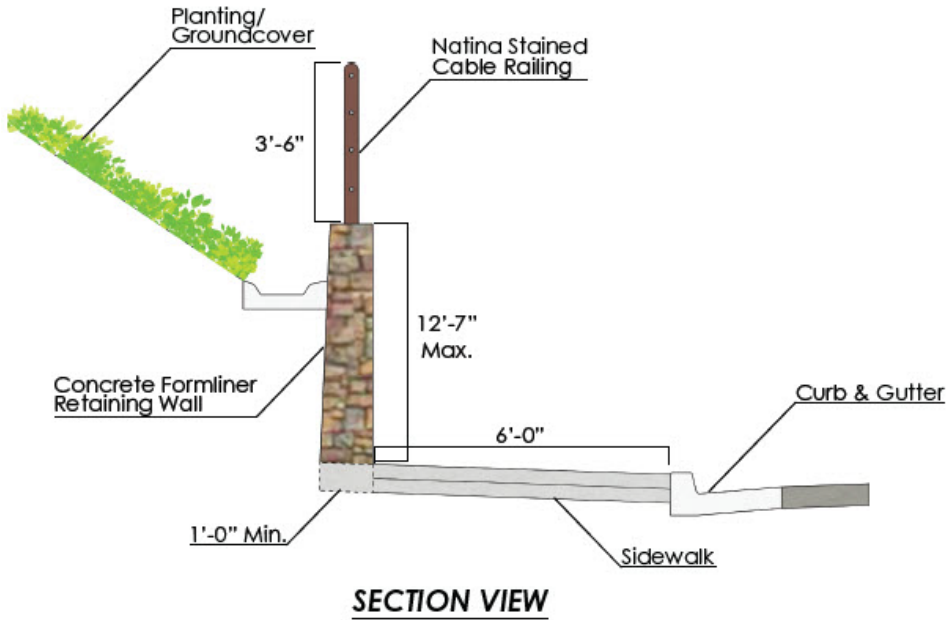

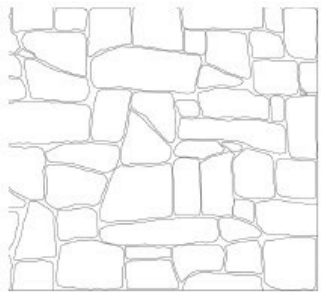

CONCRETE SURFACE TEXTURE









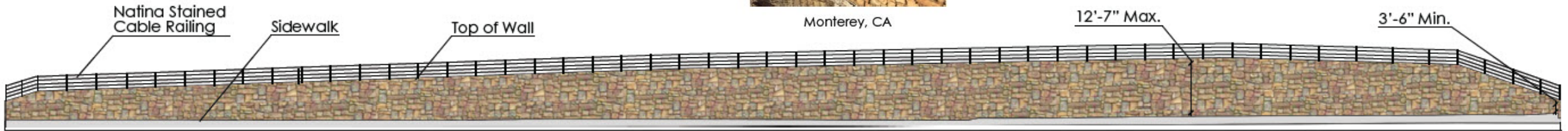
