

State Route 46 Semitropic Pavement Rehabilitation

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to resurface the existing pavement (Capital Preventive Maintenance [CAPM]) on State Route 46 (Semitropic) from 0.35 mile east of the West Side Canal to 1.0 mile west of Scofield Avenue, near the City of Wasco in Kern County.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show the project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why is called an Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration. This notice is to inform you of the preparation of the Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration and of its
