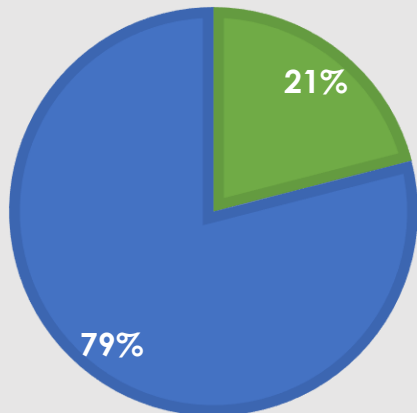

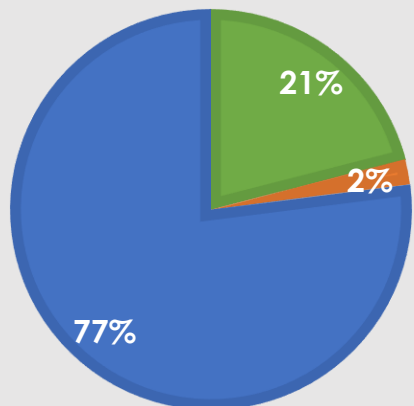

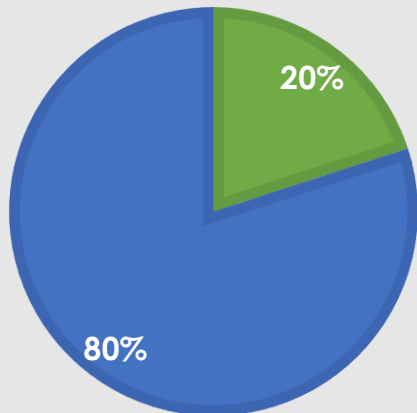

District 6 DBE, SB, and DVBE Participation at a glance:

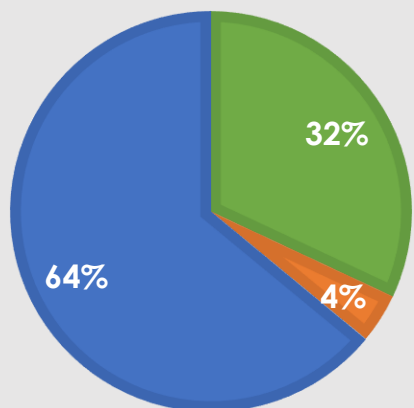
FEDERAL MAJOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS TOTAL \$113,798,181

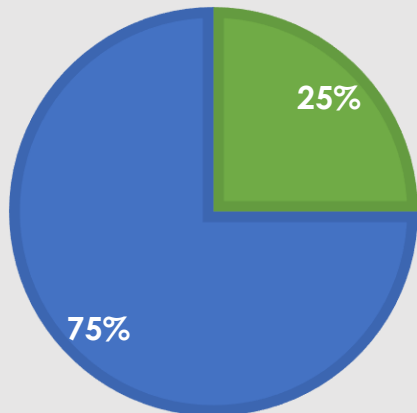

District 7 DBE, SB, and DVBE Participation at a glance:

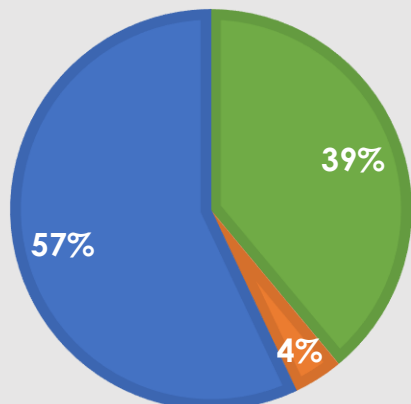
FEDERAL MAJOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS TOTAL \$352,006,572

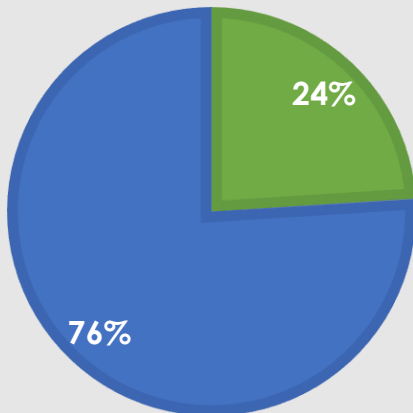

District 8 DBE, SB, and DVBE Participation at a glance:

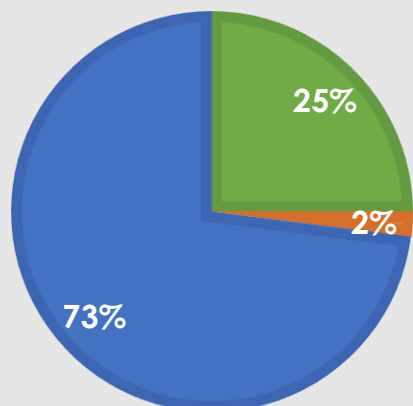
FEDERAL MAJOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS TOTAL \$213,381,564
