Sort plants alphabetically by botanical name in each plant group. Underline the first three letters of both genus and species. Underline the first letter of the variety name if used.

Edit the number of rows in the table to match the number of plant types used on the project. Don't include empty rows. If there are multiple plants in a plant group, merge the cell under the plant group column.

A row may be added for SOD as an exception to the "Plant Group" column heading.

Each plant species must have a reference number.

See "Summary of Quantities" narrative in Section 2-2.19 and Generic Summary of Quantities example sheet for additional information about standards for tables, e.g. text, line weight, etc.

Resize symbols used on the Planting Plan as needed to fit in the table. There is no compulsory convention for the plant symbols for each plant species on all projects. Shrub and tree symbols are available in the Caltrans cell library. The Caltrans cell PLTLST includes shrub and tree symbols, placed outside the sheet border, that are already resized to copy and paste into the plant legend table as needed.

PLANT GROUPS F, H, M and SOD
 Include the proposed area for plant groups F, H, M and Sod so that bidders and the contractor can verify the quantity of plants, soil amendment, and granular fertilizers in the bid item list and change orders.

Delete columns not used on the project. Do not include empty columns. If there is no entry in a cell, leave it blank, do not enter a dash.

Refer to the "Points of Measurement" detail in the Standard Plans and consider local growing expectations when determining minimum planting distances.

It is an option to add a column for root protector or foliage protector for projects that include these bid items. A column can be added for staking or staking can be indicated in the remarks column as necessary. See Landscape Example C2, Sample Plant Legend.

Describe type of plant and other special requirements such as standard, natural, or multi-trunked forms or specimen height or size.

Indicate basin type I, II, or III per Standard Plan H2.

Wood mulch types are included in the Standard Specifications.


Planting requirement notes are project specific. Show the number circled in the column heading for the applicable item or in the applicable cell for the plant species.

Common example notes include:

WOOD MULCH MUST BE XXX
 SOIL AMENDMENT MUST BE XXX
 SEE SPECIAL PROVISIONS AS SHOWN ON PROJECT PLANS
 SUFFICIENT TO RECEIVE ROOTBALL
 STAKING [or ROOT PROTECTOR or FOLIAGE PROTECTOR] REQUIRED, SEE PROJECT PLANS
 DEPARTMENT FURNISHED
 APPLICATION RATES FOR PLANT GROUPS F/H/M/SOD ARE POUNDS PER 1,000 SQFT INSTEAD OF PER PLANT

Use CF and oz on Plant Legend. Convert to CY and LB for Bid Items on the Quantity Table.

LEGEND:

-  Exist TREE TO REMAIN
-  MAINTAIN Exist PLANTED AREA
-  CULTIVATION AREA

Do not list abbreviations that are already included in the Standard Plans. Do not redefine a standard abbreviation on the project plans.

Note that although the quantity of fertilizer applied during PE is shown on the legend, that quantity is NOT included in the Bid Item shown on the planting quantities sheet.

ROW SPACING
 Use 26 feet between rows for single or double line of text so that there is room for the plant symbol. Use 36 feet between rows for triple line of text.

When the PL sheet includes the planting quantity tables (no PQ sheets), do not change the PL sheet name.
