Dear Mr. Mammano:

As required under 23 CFR 668.111(c), we request your consideration to approve Disaster CA22-10 September 2022 Tropical Storm Kay in Imperial, Inyo, Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino Counties as eligible under the Emergency Relief Program.

A Governor's Proclamation executed September 16, 2022 is included as part of the Disaster Survey Summary Report (DSSR), attached for your review. The DSSR contains the latest list of identified damaged sites and their corresponding currently estimated repair costs. The preliminary damage estimate is in the range of \$10,800,000 million for State damages and \$18,550,000 for Local damages, subject to increase. The estimated federal share of repair costs on eligible roadways will be required to exceed the \$700,000 threshold per 23 CFR 668.105(j) as indicated in the attached Damage Survey Summary Report.

Upon finding that the above Disaster is eligible, a Program of Projects will be developed and submitted to FHWA within 3 months of the Finding of Eligibility letter, as outlined in 23 CFR 668.13(a).
