Post Plant Gradation

- DIME date will be pushed out for about 3 months
- Three pilot projects completed via CCO, and about ten pilot projects via contracts in the pipeline (next construction season)

- SPF
 - o Construction is saving all the completed SPF Pay Program
 - The WPG will evaluate the data

10% RAP in RHMA-G

- Industry requested an extension to review 10% RAP in RHMA-G
- CT and Industry finalizing the PMPC Dispute Escalation Form and forward the dispute resolution to the STG.
- Working with district on pilot projects on following projects: 02-1J500 (CO), 04-1W880 (BI), 04-1W890 (BI), 07-0W140 (BI), 11-2N116 (BI).

Smoothness

- Updated HMA Smoothness specs will still be going out as NSSP
- Updated HMA (and PCC) smoothness NSSP will be converted to RSS in January 2022 (go live in April 2022)
- Smoothness adjustment spreadsheet to accommodate the updated smoothness specs is being tested out.

High RAP

Working on incorporating High RAP pilot in 4 projects.

RAS

- Evaluating JMF test results of RAS and RAS/RAP mix.
- Moving to construction of pilot test sections in D3 due to time constraint

Bin List Prioritization

- IC
- ASTG would like to know the outcome of the small group on what effort to focus on IC efforts:- ICMV, coverage map, temperature, soft spot, density, stiffness, QC tool, etc. Then ASTG can better reprioritize IC.
- Millable and Recycled Paving Fabrics
 - We have lots of questions
 - Where is this going down, what percentage of HMA, etc.
