Answer: The majority will be Cultural Task Orders that will include a lot of Native American Monitoring. There will be a couple of Paleo Task Orders, which will be lengthy.

These are the main items in the Standard Environmental Reference:

- ASR = Archaeological Survey Report (Also called Phase I)
- HPSR = Historic Property Survey Report
- ESA Action Plan = Environmentally Sensitive Area
- XPI = Extended Phase I
- AER = Archaeological Evaluation Report (Also called Phase II)
- ADR = Archaeological Data Recovery (Also called Phase III)
- Post-Review Discovery and Monitoring Plan
- HRER = Historical Resources Evaluation Report
