- ASR = Archaeological Survey Report (Also called Phase I)**
- HPSR = Historic Property Survey Report**
- ESA Action Plan = Environmentally Sensitive Area**
- XPI = Extended Phase I**
- AER = Archaeological Evaluation Report (Also called Phase II)**
- ADR = Archaeological Data Recovery (Also called Phase III)**
- Post-Review Discovery and Monitoring Plan**
- HRER = Historical Resources Evaluation Report**
